- No CFA membership or candidacy required
- Pan-European initiative, organized & financed by 8 local CFA Societies
- Students submit their original quant research
 5 to 7 pages (exc. appendices)
 Focus on practical applications rather than technique

Candidates register before 31 May

Registered candidates submit their reports before **31 August**.

Judges from all countries

Reports judged anonymously

Marks are normalized

Best papers are submitted to **Super Judge** to select 3 winners Winners announced in November

Three cash prizes:

• 1st: €3,000

2nd: €2,000

3rd: €1,000

Award Ceremony at organized by winning country

Travel and housing costs for winners are covered (with a limit of €500 per person)





















Judging

- All reports are judged anonymously
- The final mark is a weighted average of four criteria:

Applicability and relevance (30%)

Innovation (30%)

Accuracy and completeness (30%)

Presentation (10%)

- All marks are normalized
- The six papers with the highest score make it to the final
- A Super Judge determines the 3 winners to avoid biases
