- **Changes in Execution:** What adjustments in trading strategies or operational processes are necessary in this new reality?
- **Changes in Asset Allocation:** How do geopolitical factors influence the allocation across asset classes such as equities, bonds, and alternative investments?
- Other Relevant Perspectives: Contributions on additional aspects within this theme are also welcome. Authors are encouraged to submit both theoretical analyses and practical case studies that can inspire and inform investment professionals.

Submissions should be original work that has not been published elsewhere. Articles may be submitted in either **English** or **Dutch**.
